

#### **Submission of Papers**

All manuscripts should be submitted electronically to Email: secretary14act@gmail.com

#### **Manuscript Preparation**

**General**: Manuscripts must be in double-spaced form. A font size of 12 pt is required. The corresponding author should be identified (include a Full postal address, E-mail address).

**Paper Length**: Research papers should not exceed 8 printed pages including text, references, figures and tables. The number of figures and/or tables should not exceed five. Every page of the manuscript, including the title page, references, tables, etc should be numbered.

**Abstracts**: Abstracts should not exceed 100 words, and should not contain any references.

**Keywords**: 4-6 keywords must be included on a separate line below the main abstract and labelled' Keywords'.

**Text**: Follow this order when composing manuscripts: Title, Authors, Affiliations, Abstract, Keywords, Text, References, Figure Captions, Figures and then Tables. Do not import the Figures or Tables into your text. The corresponding author should be identified with an asterisk and footnote.

**References**: References should be given as shown below;
